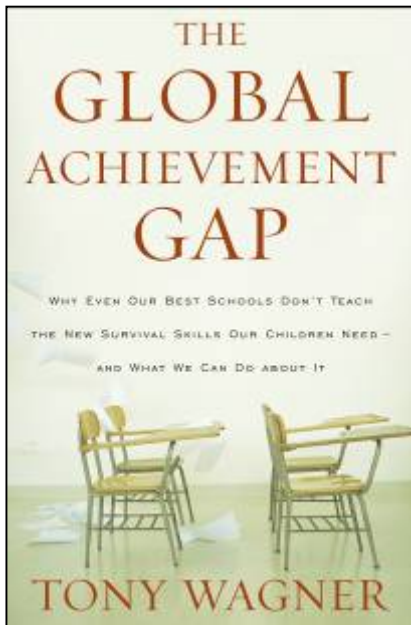


# THE GLOBAL ACHIEVEMENT GAP
